UPN/DNDF "Aviation Excellence" Scholarship Award 2021 Guidelines

The Scholarship Award is open each year to applicants in the GTA ages 16-30. This scholarship is available to applicants pursuing a career in aviation at an accredited aviation institution. The successful applicant(s) will be determined by the UPN Scholarship Committee. Recipients can receive different levels of awards based on the strength of their application. Applicants should read the guidelines carefully and ensure instructions are followed. Refer to Suggestions When Applying Form for additional guidance.

Eligibility for Award:

- A. Applicant must demonstrate a 2.5-grade average or higher during the last two years (i.e. grade 11 and 12) of secondary, pre-university preparatory schooling or current post-secondary year. Transcripts must be official academic transcripts with school seal and emailed as part of the application package to urbanpilotsnet@hotmail.com. It can also be mailed to UPN Scholarship Committee address noted on the application package.
- B. **Applicant** must show proof that he/she has been accepted into or is currently enrolled in a post-secondary

- institution. Must be planning to graduate high school during the winter or by the end of the spring school year (i.e., normally a high school senior or completing the last year of college preparatory work). If an applicant is a part of an accredited post-secondary aviation program (i.e. flight or aviation maintenance training program, then the applicant must provide proof of enrollment in the program. Copy of license, current medical and copy of logbook demonstrating hours towards course taken will be acceptable proof of enrollment.
- C. Applicant is required to be a member of the Urban Pilots Network to be eligible for the award. They are also expected to participate in future UPN programs. For membership details please go to https://urbanpilots.net/register
- D. Applicant must also demonstrate a keen interest in aviation with proof of being part of aviation activities (i.e. air cadets, flight training, etc.). Also, candidates should demonstrate being involved with volunteering in community-based programs (i.e. part of an association at school, mentoring programs, etc.)

Scholarships Not Available

- To applicants who do not intend to work without interruption for an aviation bachelor's degree, completion of an aviation diploma or certification; or
- To applicants who do not plan to enroll in an accredited aviation university, college or accredited aviation program (i.e. flight training program); or
- To applicants who do not wish to become members or participate in UPN programs.

How to Apply

To be valid for consideration, an application must be submitted on the appropriate form. Requests for the **2021** Application Packets may be obtained by downloading forms from our website at https://urbanpilots.net/scholarship. Application packets can also be obtained by emailing, calling or writing to UPN. Attention should be to the UPN Scholarship Committee in your correspondence.

Firstly, you are probably asking, 'How do I sign up as a UPN member?' If you are not already a member, please go to our

website https://urbanpilots.net/membership

Once there you can register for student or general membership by filling out the appropriate fields. A membership fee does

apply.

We have a PayPal and e-transfer option for paying for membership.

A. Concerning the essay for the scholarship application requirements. It should be no longer than one page (single-spaced) and

it should be able to answer the following:

1. Tell us about yourself.

2. Why did you choose aviation as a career and why is it important to you to succeed in aviation?

3. How important is it to contribute to your community and tell us how you have done that in the past?

4. Tell us of at least two proud accomplishments (awards, achieving leadership role, etc.)

5. How important is it to have minorities in aviation, and what does that mean to you?

6. Why do you believe you should get this award?

We sometimes get questions in regards to what to write so this is a basic guideline.

B. Concerning the Photo. It can be scanned and sent to us as part of the application packet. Make sure it's something you want

public because if you are selected it will be used at the dinner and for scholarship promotional uses.

C. Reference letters, as discussed, one can be from your parent and the other should be from a teacher, supervisor, or another

person who can vouch for your character.

D. Application once received can be downloaded and filled in using Word, or you can write information in, scan it and send it

back with other required documents.

E. Transcripts should be an official copy. If you already have a copy you can scan those as well and email it back with your

required documents.

Remember May 14, 2021 is the deadline. Hope that helps and again all the best!
